

















## CHAT CHARTS

**PREMISE:** The students in pairs or groups keep track of the turns they have on diagrams with pens or colorful markers.

### 1. SMILES CHAT CHART

You or the students write the names of the students in the group down the left side. Then each time a student takes a turn to speak, he or she fills in the mouth and eyes of a smiling face in a circle on the chart.

Smiles Chat Charts may be also be made for groups of any size, from 3 to 5.

They may be made for any number of turns (3, 4, or 5, etc.)
